



Farm Animal Top Priorities

Support Residents

Bovine Isolation Stall

Dedicated space for housing sick or high-risk cattle to prevent disease transmission. Equipped with separate air, water, and feed sources, it supports biosecurity by minimizing contact with other livestock and allowing safe treatment and monitoring.

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Ward Renovation

Secure, individual enclosures for housing large animals like cattle or horses during treatment or recovery. Designed for safety, biosecurity, and comfort, they support flexible use for medical care, isolation, or foaling, with durable materials and easy-clean surfaces.

Fluid Syringe Pump

Provides accurate, timed delivery of medications or fluids to calves, foals, or other small or compromised farm animals. Especially useful for administering antibiotics, electrolytes, or anesthesia in controlled doses.
