## After-hours Urgent Care Services

We address issues that your family veterinarian also addresses, but we do it after-hours when your veterinarian is not available. Some of the non-emergent conditions we treat include:

- Loss of appetite
- Urinary tract infections
- Mild lameness, limping, general discomfort
- Fracture assessments
- Minor wounds & lacerations

Digital X-ray, full IDEXX diagnostic lab suite and comprehensive pharmacy on-site.


